### **Sign Language at St Andrew's Day Nursery**

Makaton is the sign and symbol language we use within the Nursery. With many children their understanding sometimes develops ahead of their speech. Using signs can help children who have limited or no speech, this might be due to communication difficulties/ language barriers or are very young, or whose speech is unclear.
